



MTR 2027 Vendor Rules

All Midwest Tandem Rally 2027 Vendors are required to adhere to the following rules:

1. Central Wisconsin Convention and Expo Center has equipment and services available to MTR 2027 vendors. Vendor understands that they must contact the MTR 2027 Co-Directors regarding rent/use of these items/services no later than August 15, 2027. MTR Co-Directors will notify Vendor of the CWCEC cost; vendor agrees to pay such costs no later than September 3, 2027, at vendor check-in.
2. Vendor Applications will be accepted until August 20, 2027, if space is still available.
3. Vendors will set up on Friday, September 3, 2027, from 9am-3:30pm.
4. Vendors agree that they will not tear down their booth prior to Sunday, September 5 at 4:30pm. Vendors may tear down on Monday, September 6 from 8am-10am with prior notification to the MTR 2027 Co-Directors.
5. Vendors understand that the Vendor Exhibit Hall will be locked by CWCEC staffers outside of the posted Vendor Exhibit Hall hours.
6. Cancellation Policy: There are No Refunds for cancellations after July 31, 2027. Any cancellation prior to this date will result in a full refund back to the vendor.
7. All Vendors will be required to follow the rules of the Central Wisconsin Convention & Expo Center which include the following:
 - a. No Helium balloons may be used, sold or distributed.
 - b. Decorations or materials may not be taped, nailed, tacked, stapled, or otherwise fastened to ceilings, doors, floors, walls, glass, columns, painted surfaces, fabric, or decorative walls.
 - c. Glitter, Confetti, and similar items are prohibited.
 - d. Do not use gum as a decoration or giveaway to guests.
 - e. Pressure-adhesive stickers or decals or similar promotional items cannot be distributed or sold within the facility.
 - f. Painting of any kind is prohibited.
 - g. Lit candles are prohibited.
 - h. MTR 2027 and CWCEC will not store any items after the Event unless agreed upon ahead of time nor be responsible for lost or stolen items.
 - i. All vendors will, to the best of their ability, leave CWCEC as they found it.
 - j. Any damage to CWCEC caused by the vendor will be reported to the vendor and the vendor understands that they may be responsible for any damage or excessive cleaning costs.
